12TH ANNUAL MEETING

IPEC held its 12th annual meeting on May 6, 2016 at the Kake Community Hall. Mayor Chris Bitterman welcomed everyone in attendance. We had 81 people registered which is our highest number in our 12 year history. Way to go Kake! We were also honored to have the Keex Kwaan Dance Group perform for us and they received \$403 in contributions from attendees for Celebration of which IPEC contributed \$150.

Legal Counsel Andy Leman announced that we had 201 ballots cast with 17 being invalid since they were not signed. In the future, please make sure you sign the outside of the ballot envelope or otherwise it will not be counted. There were 159 mail in ballots and 42 people voted in person at the annual meeting. Shayne Thompson received 74 votes for the Angoon District. Richard George received 112 votes and was re-elected as the Angoon Director. Larry Beck ran unopposed receiving 161 votes and was re-elected as the Chilkat Valley Director. Both positions are for a three year term. Our Bylaw Amendment also passed receiving 120 yes votes and 71 no votes. Many thanks to our Ballot Counters Pauline James from Kake, JJ Pate from Hoonah, and Cynthia Frank from Angoon.

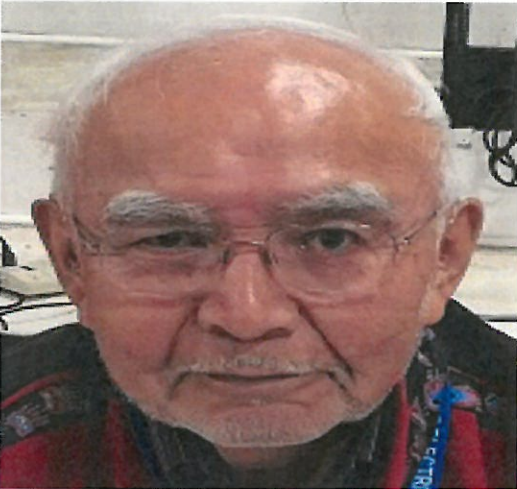

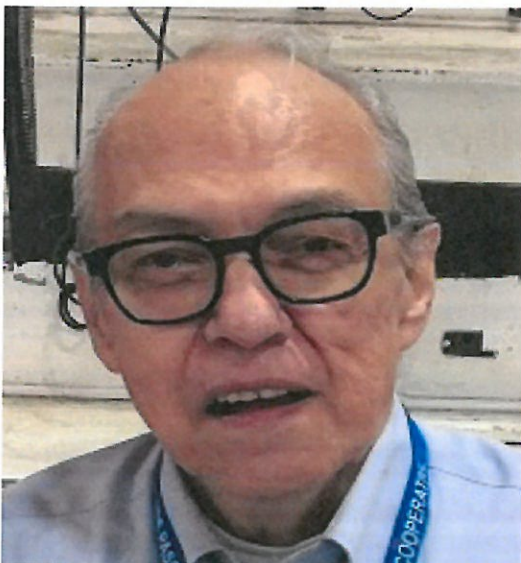
