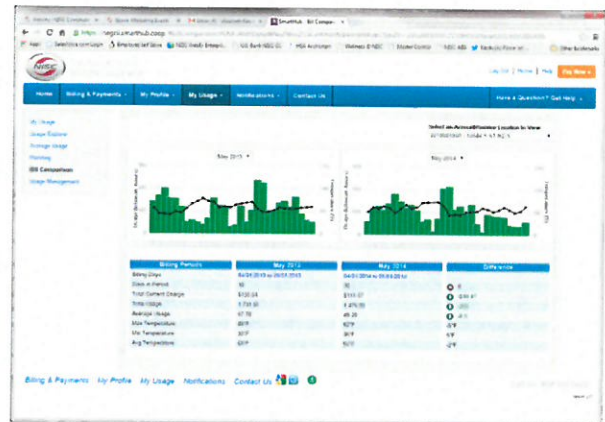

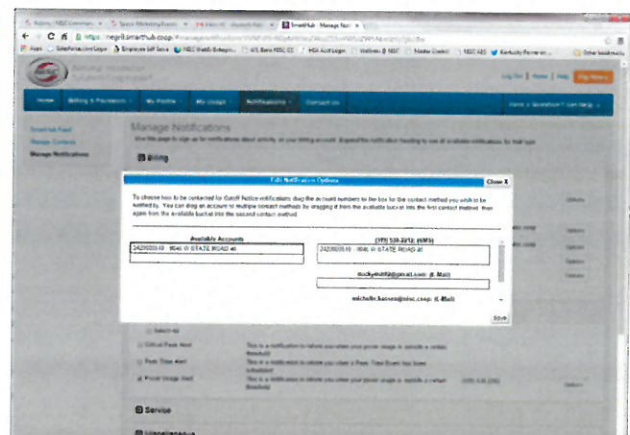

SMARTHUB



You may have heard about SmartHub, IPEC's new innovative tool for account management, but what can it do for you? SmartHub can help you take control of your electricity and your IPEC account like never before.

SmartHub has several features that make managing your account as easy as possible. Whether through the web, or your smartphone or tablet (Android or iOS), you'll be able to pay your bill, and view your electricity use.

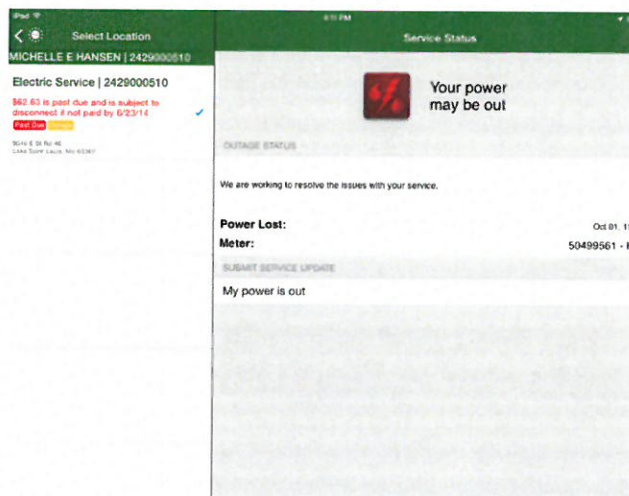


As soon as you log in, you'll be able to view your billing history and make a payment with just a

couple of clicks...or taps, if you're using the app! You'll see your current bill, along with bills from the previous month or even the previous summer, if you want to compare costs. Not only will you see your billing history, but you'll be able to view your actual electricity use. You can see how your use is trending over time, which will allow you to take steps to reduce your consumption and lower your bill.

Making payments through SmartHub is fast and easy. The first time you make a payment either through the Web or through your mobile device, you'll be able to securely store your payment information for future transactions. The next time you need to pay your bill, it will only take a couple of clicks.



You'll also be able to manage your account notifications with SmartHub. By logging in to SmartHub on the Web, you'll be able to select how you want to be notified about your bill, including email and text messaging.

Access SmartHub by visiting www.insidepassageelectric.org or by downloading the app on your mobile device through the Apple App Store (iPhone or iPad) or Google Play Marketplace (Android phone or tablet). SmartHub should be available. SmartHub will go live on May 23, 2017. 🌱
